


General Fund – why the deficit?

- We actually spent less than budgeted but ...
- Provision giving fell compared to 2020, whereas we had been aiming for an increase
- Lettings income was reduced because of
 - the closure of the Mama Bears Nursery in Oakfield Road
 - The Whitwells moving into Linden Gate




How can we increase income?

- Many people who give by standing order have not changed them for years
- Lots of people have joined Christ Church in the last 18 months
- We could hit our target if for example, existing givers could increase their giving by 5%, and we gained 10% new regular givers
- The loss in rental income can be replaced eventually but the timescales for this are uncertain.

The four golden rules for giving

- give regularly
- a planned amount
- tell us about it
- and Gift Aid it if you can



RENEW – closing the shortfall

- No grant applications are now outstanding
- There is some income from users of the crypt, this could increase
- Could publicise our activities and appeal to the wider community for support
- The PCC will review and decide the way forward
- We are being loaned the amount outstanding by the contractor at 3% pa

Audit – process and outcome

- Because of RENEW, our income was again over the £1m threshold so we required a full audit rather than the usual independent examination
- This involves a forensic examination of files and processes, to ensure we have documentary evidence for all figures presented in accounts
- The audit findings represent a vote of confidence in the quality of our financial management and record-keeping
