Latest Report

A hardy group of Christchurch men agreed to accompany me on a day sail based in Plymouth. These shipmates included David Daniels, Chris Davis, John Griffin, Ben Nias, Howard Greeves and Alasdair Groves.

We gained permission from the charter company, Liberty Yachts of Queen Anne's battery in Plymouth, to sleep on board Bertie on the night of 22/23 June at no extra charge. Bertie is a 44 foot Bavaria and can take 10 crew.

The morning of Thursday 23 June was a bright one with sun and a gentle breeze - ideal for a bunch of land lubbers to get their sea legs! After a safety briefing we set all sail and first circumnavigated Drake's Island passing through the narrow buoyed channel known as "the Bridge" to the west of the island. All the crew had a go at helming the boat, pulling up sails, adjusting sails and generally learning how to sail a yacht.

At lunchtime we anchored off Cawsand just outside the breakwater and 2 energetic souls inflated the dinghy and rowed ashore to buy genuine Cornish pasties. After lunch the breeze increased enabling us all to enjoy some exhilarating sailing between Cawsand and the mouth to the River Yealm. Then it was time to return to base and back home.

From the conversations I have had since, everyone seemed to have a good time and at least 1 member of the crew has caught the sailing bug and has sailed with me subsequently. Some wives have been put out that they have not been invited too! That can be remedied on another occasion with a mixed crew.

Thanks are due to Simon Beeby who runs the charter company for agreeing to accompany us on the day at no charge, to act as my second in command as I always need at least one other experienced sailor when sailing.
